

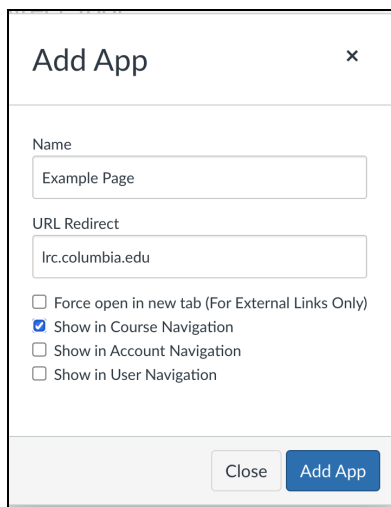
1. External Websites

1.1 Recommended Integration Method: Redirect Tool

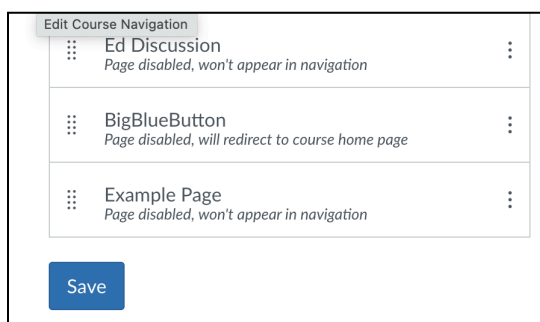
1. Settings → Apps → Redirect Tool



2. Add app as in the image below. Make sure to use the complete copied link from your URL bar.



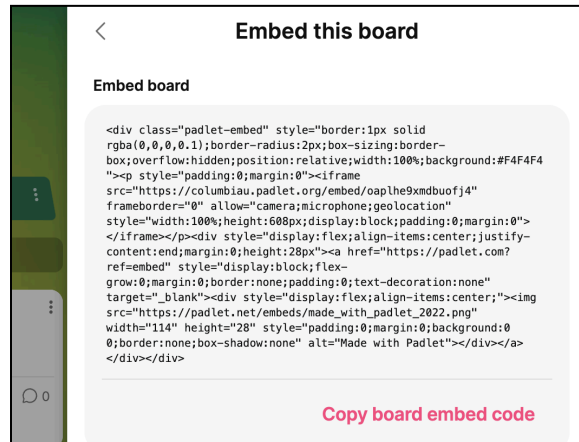
3. In the Navigation tab, drag your link to the desired location and hit “save.”



2. Padlets

Recommended Integration Method: **Dependent on goals**

2.1 If assigning a Padlet as an Assignment: Embed it within the Assignment.



1. Padlet → Share → Embed → Copy board embed code.
2. Add a new assignment, and click on the three dots in the editor to find the cloud-shaped embed icon.



3. Copy the embed code in the box that appears, and proceed as usual building the assignment.

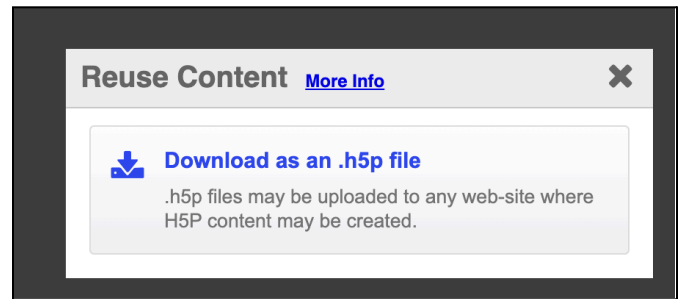
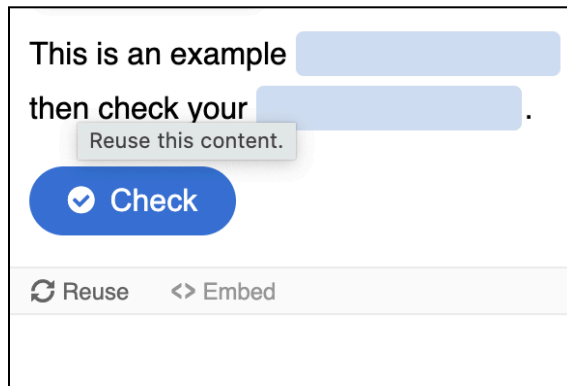
2.2 If sharing all Padlets in one place: Embed them on one Page, and add that Page to the Navigation panel via the Redirect Tool.

1. Copy the padlet board embed code, as above.
2. In Navigation, Pages → View All Pages → Plus Button.
3. Make a new page called “Padlets” (or your choice).
4. Find the embed icon again and copy the Padlet code. You can do this multiple times, stacking Padlets on top of each other. I recommend inserting a space or some text between each one.

3. H5P & Other Responsive Content

3.1 Recommended Integration Method: **SCORM Packaging** (for completion checking)

1. Log in to your H5P account. Find the activity you want to use on Canvas.
2. Click “Reuse” and download the .h5p file.



3. Use this tool to convert the .h5p file into a SCORM package:
<https://translate-h5p.tk/scorm-h5p/>. Note - if your downloader automatically unzips this zip file, compress it again before uploading it.
4. Upload the SCORM package to Canvas. (Make sure SCORM is in the Navigation panel).
5. Choose “Upload as graded/ungraded assignment.”
6. Find the new file under Assignments.
7. Display grade as “Complete/Incomplete.”
8. When students complete the assignment with 100% accuracy, Canvas records the assignment as complete.
9. Did you know you can also do this with a free website called [LearningApps.org](https://learningapps.org/)? It has similar functionality to H5P and lets you download SCORM packages directly.

3.2 Other options: **Embedding** (as a Padlet, above)

1. Follow steps 1-2 above; copy the embed code for your H5P activity and
